On January 15, 2021, Disciplinary Panel A (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Cheng Tan entered into a Consent Order, wherein Panel A concluded, as a matter of law, that Mr. Tan misrepresented to the public, by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise, that he was authorized to practice medicine in Maryland and that he used the words or terms "Dr.", "doctor", "physician", "D.O.", or "M.D.", with the intent to represent that he practices medicine. 1 Mr. Tan was ordered to cease and desist from mispresenting himself to the public, by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise, that he is authorized to practice medicine in this State and from using the words or terms "Dr.", "doctor", "physician", or "M.D." with the intent to represent that he practices medicine and ordered to pay a fine of \$2,500.00 within one (1) year. Mr. Tan has paid the \$2,500.00 fine. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the fine imposed by the January 15, 2021 Consent Order has been **SATIFFIED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that Mr. Tan shall continue to cease and desist from mispresenting himself to the public, by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise, that he is authorized to
