
**ORDER**

On February 1, 2018, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and UMMC entered into a public Consent Order, wherein the Board concluded that UMMC failed to report to the Board within 10 days that it terminated 3 unlicensed medical practitioners<sup>1</sup> for reasons that could have been considered grounds for discipline under Health Occ. II §14-404.<sup>2</sup> UMMC agreed to pay a fine of a total of \$6000 within six months of the Consent Order. UMMC has paid the \$6000 fine. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the payment of the fine has been **SATISFIED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a public document.
