**ORDER SUSPENDING LICENSE TO PRACTICE**  
**PERFUSION IN THE STATE OF MARYLAND**

On June 17, 2021, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Stephen L. Robinson entered into a Consent Order, wherein Panel B concluded, as a matter of law, that Mr. Robinson failed to submit to a criminal history records check (“CHRC”).<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to the Consent Order, Mr. Robinson was reprimanded, ordered to complete the CHRC process **WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS** from the effective date of the Consent Order (June 17, 2021), and ordered to pay a civil fine of \$500.00 within six (6) months of the Consent Order. The Consent Order further ordered that if Mr. Robinson failed to complete the CHRC process and the Board did not receive the completed CHRC report within 60 days from the effective date of the Consent Order, Mr. Robinson’s license shall be automatically suspended from the 61<sup>st</sup> day until the Board receives Mr. Robinson’s completed CHRC report.

Mr. Robinson has paid the \$500.00 civil fine. The Board did not receive a completed CHRC report. It is thus, pursuant to the June 17, 2021 Consent Order of Disciplinary Panel B, hereby

**ORDERED** that Mr. Robinson’s license to practice perfusion in the State of Maryland is hereby **SUSPENDED**; and it is further
