CONSENT ORDER

On or about September 6, 2023, Disciplinary Panel A ("Panel A") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board"), opened an investigation of Gafari Oyedokun, Polysomnographic Technologist (the "Respondent"), under the Maryland Polysomnography Act (the "Act"), Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. ("Health Occ.") §§ 14-5C-01 *et seq*.

Based on its investigation, the Board has grounds to charge the Respondent under the following provision of the Act:

Health Occ. § 14-5C-20. Practicing without license prohibited.

Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a person may not practice, attempt to practice, or offer to practice polysomnography in this State unless licensed to practice polysomnography by the Board.

Prior to Panel A issuing charges, the Respondent agreed to enter into this public Consent Order with the Panel A's approval, consisting of Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Panel A finds the following:

 The Respondent was originally licensed by the Board to practice polysomnography on October 1, 2013.

- 2. The Respondent's license was set to expire on May 30, 2023; however, the Respondent did not renew his license by the expiration date.
- 3. The Respondent continued to practice as a polysomnographic technologist in Maryland from May 31, 2023 to August 29, 2023.
- On July 18, 2023, the Respondent filed an Application for Reinstatement of Polysomnographic Technologist.
- 5. In his application the Respondent admitted to practicing as a polysomnographic technologist in Maryland from "November 2013 to present."
- The Respondent, thus, practiced polysomnography without a license from approximately May 31, 2023 to August 29, 2023.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Disciplinary Panel A concludes that the Respondent engaged in the unauthorized practice of polysomnography in Maryland, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-5C-20.

ORDER

It is, thus, by Disciplinary Panel A, hereby:

ORDERED that, within 90 (NINETY) DAYS of the effective date of this Consent Order, the Respondent shall pay a civil fine of \$250.00 by bank certified check or money order made payable to the Maryland Board of Physicians, P.O. Box 37217, Baltimore, Maryland 21297. The Board will not renew or reinstate the Respondent's license if the Respondent fails to timely pay the fine to the Board.; and it is further

ORDERED that the effective date of the Consent Order is the date the Consent Order is signed by the Executive Director of the Board or her designee. The Executive Director or her

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designee signs the Consent Order on behalf of the disciplinary panel which has imposed the terms and conditions of this Consent Order; and it is further

ORDERED that this Consent Order is a public document. See Health Occ. §§ 1-607, 14-411.1(b)(2) and Gen. Prov. § 4-333(b)(6); and it is further

I voluntarily enter into and agree to comply with the terms and conditions set forth in the Consent Order as a resolution of the charges. I waive any right to contest the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Order set out in the Consent Order. I waive all rights to appeal this Consent Order.
