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**ORDER**


On March 20, 2002, the Maryland Board of Physician Quality Assurance (the “Board”)<sup>1</sup> and William Ellis, M.D. entered into a Consent Order in which Dr. Ellis was reprimanded and ordered to comply with all terms and conditions of the January 29, 2001, Decision of the Medical Board of California (the “California Board”). The Board’s action was taken pursuant to section 14-404(a)(21) of the Health Occupations Article, which authorizes the Board to discipline a licensee if the licensee is disciplined by another licensing or disciplinary authority for an act that would be grounds for discipline under section 14-404 of the Health Occupations Article. On June 18, 2001, the California Board notified Dr. Ellis that the terms of the January 29, 2001, Decision, were satisfied. Thus, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the terms and conditions of the March 20, 2002, Consent Order are hereby **SATISFIED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a public document.
