ORDER

On June 30, 2017, the Maryland State Board of Physicians ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order reprimanding Norman B. Rosen, M.D., for failure to meet appropriate standards for the delivery of quality medical care, and unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine for failure to adequately supervise the opioid prescribing practices of a physician assistant employed at his practice, in violation of the Medical Practice Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 14-404(a)(22) and (3)(ii), respectively. On March 9, 2018, in Case No. 03-C-17-6833, the Circuit Court for Baltimore County affirmed: (1) the Board's decision that Dr. Rosen's opioid prescribing violated the standard of quality medical care; and (2) the sanction of a reprimand. The circuit court reversed the Board's decision that Dr. Rosen was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine.

In accordance with the Opinion and Order of the Circuit Court for Baltimore County, the Board hereby REVERSES its decision that Dr. Rosen was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine.

This Order may be subject to revision in accordance with any order of court resulting from an appeal of the order of the Circuit Court for Baltimore County.
