TERMINATION OF PROBATION


On September 20, 2016, the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health and Francesco Lupis, M.D. entered a Consent Order wherein Dr. Lupis was reprimanded and placed on probation with certain terms and conditions. On November 22, 2016, based upon the Connecticut Order, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Dr. Lupis entered a Consent Order wherein Dr. Lupis was reprimanded and placed on probation subject to the terms and conditions in the Connecticut Order for the duration that the Connecticut Order remained in effect.¹ On October 5, 2016, the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health notified Dr. Lupis that the terms of the September 20, 2016, Consent Order were satisfied.² Thus, it is hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the Consent Order, issued by the Maryland Board, dated November 22, 2016, is hereby **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
