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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On October 23, 2013, the Maryland State Board of Physicians and Richard E. Layton, M.D., entered into a consent order under which Dr. Layton was reprimanded, certain permanent conditions were placed on his license, and he was placed on probation for a minimum of two years with probationary terms and conditions.¹ The permanent terms and conditions included a restriction on administering chelation therapy for any purpose or administering ketoconazole, itraconazole, and/or fluconazole for non-FDA purposes. Among the probationary terms and conditions, Dr. Layton was required to pay a fine of \$5,000.00 within two years, a chart and/or peer review, and certain requirements of informed consent and requirement to provide the Board with a copy of informed consent forms prior to engaging in alternative or complementary treatments. Dr. Layton has paid the \$5,000.00 fine and has successfully complied with the probationary terms and conditions and the probation period of two years has passed. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation is **TERMINATED**.

ORDERED that the Board's Reprimand of Dr. Layton remains in effect; and it is further
