NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW

Any petition for judicial review shall be made as provided for in the Administrative Procedure Act, Md. Code Ann., State Gov't § 10-222 and Title 7, Chapter 200 of the Maryland Rules of Procedure.
