TERMINATION ORDER

BACKGROUND

By Consent Order (attached hereto as Exhibit A) dated October 22, 1997, the Board of Physician Quality Assurance (the "Board") found Stephen D. Brown, M.D. (The "Respondent") guilty of committing prohibited acts as set forth in the Maryland Medical Practice Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. Specifically, the Board found Respondent guilty of \$14-404(a)(3) with respect to completion of continuing medical education as required by \$14-316 and Code of Maryland Regulations ("COMAR") 10.32.01. Respondent was fined and subject to conditions.

At its meeting on October 21, 1998, the Board reviewed information regarding Respondent's compliance with the conditions of the October 22, 1997 Order. Based upon the Board's review of the information, the Board determined that Respondent had fulfilled the conditions contained in the October 22, 1997 Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Based on the information known and available to it, the

Board finds that Respondent complied with all of the conditions of the October 22, 1997 Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that Respondent has satisfactorily complied with all of the conditions as set forth in the October 22, 1997 Order.

ORDER

Upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is this day of October 1998, by a majority vote of the full authorized membership of the Board

ORDERED that effective as of the date of this Order, the conditions imposed upon Respondent by the Board's October 22, 1997 Order are hereby TERMINATED and of no further force and effect; and be it further

ORDERED that this is a Final Order and as such is considered a public document pursuant to the Maryland Public Information Act, State Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, \$\$10-611 et seq., specifically \$10-617)(h)(2)(vi).
