CONSENT ORDER

BACKGROUND

The Maryland Board of Physicians (the "Maryland Board") received information that James McGuckin Jr., M.D., (the "Respondent") (D.O.B. 11/07/1961), License Number D62353, was disciplined by the Washington Medical Quality Assurance Commission (the "Washington Board"). In an Order dated October 1, 2015, the Washington Board disciplined the Respondent by issuing a \$17, 500 fine with terms and conditions.

Based on the above referenced Washington Board sanction, the Maryland Board has grounds to charge the Respondent with violating the following provisions of the Maryland Medical Practice Act (the "Act"), under H. O. § 14-404(a):

- (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-405 of this subtitle, a disciplinary panel, on the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum of the disciplinary panel, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:
 - (21) Is disciplined by a licensing or disciplinary authority or convicted or disciplined by a court of any state or country or disciplined by any branch of the United States uniformed services or the Veteran's Administration for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action under this section,

The Maryland Board has determined that the acts for which the Respondent was disciplined in Washington would be grounds for disciplinary action under H.O. § 14-404(a) are as follows:

- (3) Is guilty of:
 - (ii) Unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine;
- (20) Offers, undertakes, or agrees to cure or treat disease by a secret method, treatment, or medicine

Based on the action taken by the Washington Board, the Respondent agrees to enter into this Consent Order with the Maryland Board of Physicians, consisting of Procedural Background, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order of reciprocal action.

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board finds the following:

- At all times relevant hereto, the Respondent was a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maryland. The Respondent was initially licensed in Maryland on or about October 12, 2004.
- 2. By Stipulated Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and agreed Order dated October 1, 2015, the Washington Board disciplined the Respondent by issuing a fine of \$17,500 with terms and conditions based upon his care and treatment of chronic cerebrospinal venous insufficiency (CCSVI) in multiple sclerosis (MS) patients without the required Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved Investigational Device Exemption (IDE). The Respondent also represented that he adhered to the Institutional Review Board (IRB) protocol when he deviated from it.

A copy of the Washington Board Order is attached hereto.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Maryland Board concludes as a matter of law that the disciplinary action taken by the Washington Board against the Respondent was for an act or acts that would be grounds for disciplinary action under Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(21) had those offenses been committed in this state.

III. ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the Respondent is hereby subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a. The Respondent shall not perform angioplasty and stenting procedures of the venous system for CCSVI or MS patients in the state of Maryland;
- The Respondent shall comply with the terms and conditions of the October 1,
 Washington Board Order;
- c. If the Respondent fails to comply with any term or condition of this Consent

 Order, a Board panel, after notice and an opportunity to be heard, may take any action

 prescribed under Section 14-404(a) of the Maryland Medical Practice Act which includes
 a reprimand, probation, or the suspension or revocation of the Respondent's medical

 license;

ORDERED that this **CONSENT ORDER** is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann. Gen. Prov. §§ 4-101 through 4-601 (2014).
