ORDER

In a Consent Order dated September 4, 2014, the Mississippi State Board of Medical Licensure (the “Mississippi Board”) disciplined Anthony V. Dallas Jr., M.D. (the “Respondent”) by suspending his license for three (3) months subject to probationary terms and conditions. Based on the action taken by the Mississippi Board, on February 5, 2015, the Maryland Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and the Respondent entered into a public Consent Order¹ in which the Respondent’s license to practice medicine was suspended for three months. The suspension of the Respondent’s Maryland medical license was terminated on May 14, 2015 and the Respondent was placed on probation².

On November 12, 2015, the Mississippi Board issued a public Order terminating the probation it imposed on the Respondent’s Mississippi medical license. Because the probation imposed by the Mississippi Board has been terminated, it is hereby;

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation dated May 14, 2015, is hereby **TERMINATED**; and it is further
