

2023 LICENSE RENEWAL INFORMATION FOR PERFUSIONISTS-ADVANCED

For inquiries, contact the license renewal unit at 410-764-4705 or 1-800-492-6836, ext. 4705, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The license renewal period will begin on **December 4, 2023**. To maintain an active Maryland license, licensees must submit a license renewal application and renewal fee of **\$221.00** to the Maryland Board of Physicians (the Board) by January 31, 2024. The online license renewal application will be accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week, on the Board's website from **December 4, 2023, through January 31, 2024**. The license renewal application will not be available after January 31, 2024.

Failure to renew by **11:59 p.m. (EST) on January 31, 2024**, will result in the expiration of your license to practice in Maryland. If your license expires and you intend to practice in Maryland, you must complete and submit a [reinstatement application](#) and apply for a new [criminal history records check](#).

No action is required if you do not plan to renew your license.

NEW - Implicit Bias Training Required for 2023 License Renewal

On April 1, 2022, a new [law](#) went into effect requiring all healthcare practitioners applying for license renewal to complete an implicit bias training program course. This is a **one-time** requirement. You must attest on the renewal application that you have completed the program.

If you need to complete a course, click [here](#) to find a list of approved implicit bias training courses provided by the Maryland Office of Minority Health and Health Disparities. The Board will accept any accredited implicit bias training course taken since your last license renewal in 2021 to fulfill the training requirement.

Note - you are **not** required to submit proof of course completion to the Board. However, it is recommended that you keep your certificate of completion as proof of registration. For courses that do not provide a certificate of completion, we recommend you retain proof of registration or a screenshot of the completion screen for your records.

To log in and complete the renewal application, you will need:

- Your Maryland license number;
- The last four digits of your social security number;
- A Visa, MasterCard, or Discover credit card.

You cannot access the online application if:

- Your license is expired. If your license is expired, you must reactivate it by submitting a reinstatement application. Click [here](#) for a reinstatement application.
- You have an unresolved tax liability issue with the Comptroller's Office of Maryland. Please contact the Maryland Comptroller's Office at 410-974-2432 or 1-888-674-0016. The Board cannot assist you with unresolved tax obligations.

Name change:

- You cannot submit a name change in the online application. To change the name on your license, you must file an Allied Health Name Change application *separate* from the license renewal application to the Board. Click [here](#) for a name change application.

**The renewal fee generally includes an assessment fee payable to the Maryland Health Care Commission. For fiscal year 2024, the Board will pay the assessment fee of \$26.00 to the Maryland Health Care Commission for each renewing licensee.*

Continuing education (CE) and audit:

- To satisfy the CE requirement, licensees must maintain current certification with the American Board of Cardiovascular Perfusion (ABCP).

Note: Licensees may be randomly selected to be audited by the Board. If you receive a pop-up notice while renewing your license, you must send proof of current certification by the ABCP to the Board for review by February 15, 2024. Send your ABCP documentation by mail **or** email to:

License printing:

- You can print your new license immediately after submission of the application and payment. The Board's website will reflect your new expiration date within two business days after you submit your application.
- If a printer is not available, you can return later to [log in](#) and print your license, a copy of the application, and a payment receipt.
