

Recruitment for Committee Vacancy

Dear Perfusionists:

The Maryland Board of Physicians (the Board) is looking to fill a vacant perfusionist position on the Perfusion Advisory Committee (the Committee). Successful candidates must:

- Hold an active and unencumbered Maryland Perfusionist-Advanced license; and
- Be a Maryland resident.

The Committee consists of three licensed perfusionists, three licensed physicians, at least one of whom performs cardiac or cardio-thoracic surgery or is a cardiac or cardio-thoracic anesthesiologist, and one consumer member.

The role of the Committee is to advise the Board on matters relating to the practice of perfusion. The duties of the Committee can be found in [Health Occupations Article, §14-5E-07](#), Annotated Code of Maryland.

Meetings are held virtually on the first Thursday in April and October, starting at 4:00 p.m. However, there may be occasions when meetings are held at the Board's office in the Metro Executive Building, located at 4201 Patterson Avenue, Baltimore. Attendance is essential.

Committee members serve staggered three-year terms. Members may be reappointed for a second term; however, no individual may serve more than two consecutive three-year terms.

A candidate appointed to the Committee may not serve concurrently as a member of the Advisory Committee and as an elected officer in their professional association. ([Health Occupations Article §1-222\(b\)](#), Annotated Code of Maryland.)

Candidates will also be required to complete and submit a Biographical Information Form, an Appointee Exemption Disclosure Form, and a Candidate Questionnaire, which will be provided later in the application process.
