

## Recruitment for Committee Vacancy

Dear Physicians:

The Maryland Board of Physicians (the Board) is looking to fill two physician positions on the Respiratory Care Advisory Committee (the Committee). Successful candidates must:

- Hold an active, unencumbered Maryland license;
- Be a specialist in anesthesiology or pulmonary medicine; and
- Be a Maryland resident.

The Committee consists of three licensed respiratory care practitioners, three licensed physicians (one of whom is a specialist in thoracic surgery, one in pulmonary medicine, and one in anesthesiology), and one consumer member.

The role of the Committee is to advise the Board on matters relating to the practice of respiratory care. The duties of the Committee are found in [Health Occupations Article, §14-5A-07](#), Annotated Code of Maryland.

Meetings are held virtually on the second Thursday in February, May, and November, starting at 10:00 a.m. However, there may be occasions when meetings are held at the Board's office in the Metro Executive Building, 4201 Patterson Avenue, Baltimore. Attendance is essential.

Committee members serve staggered three-year terms. Members may be reappointed for a second term; however, no individual may serve more than two consecutive three-year terms.

A candidate appointed to the Committee may not serve concurrently as a member of the Advisory Committee and as an elected officer in their professional association. ([Health Occupations Article §1-222\(b\)](#), Annotated Code of Maryland.)

Candidates will also be required to complete and submit a Biographical Information Form, an Appointee Exemption Disclosure Form, and a Candidate Questionnaire, which will be provided later in the application process.
