Regulations

Proposed Regulations - COMAR 10.32.21.05 & .10 for Approval

Ms. DelGreco presented proposed amendments to COMAR 10.32.21.05 & .10. The Board voted to approve posting the amendments to the website to solicit public comment, and, if no public comments are received, to proceed to the next step of the promulgation process.

On a motion made by <u>Ms. Ganti</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Cymet</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> posting these proposed amendments to the Board's website for public review and comments, if no comments are received, to proceed with the promulgation process.

Proposed Regulations - COMAR 10.32.03 (Physician Assistants) Update and Approval

Mr. Tran informed the Board that the draft of COMAR 10.32.03 will complete its posting on the Board's website for solicitation of public comment on 05/01/25. He also mentioned that the Board did not receive any public comments. The Board discussed and approved the regulations to proceed with the regulation promulgation process if no public comments are received by 05/01/2025.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Ganti</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Hann</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> proceeding with the promulgation process if no comments are received.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Ms. DelGreco informed the Board that SB 423/HB 776, the Maryland Medical Practice Act and Maryland Physicians Assistants Act - Revision, had successfully passed the 2025 legislative session, and that the subsequent regulation amendments would be forthcoming.

Mr. Tran informed the Board that several bills passed during the session that the Board's legislative committee tracked. These included SB 67 (Health Occupations Boards - Notation of Veteran Status and Eligibility for Benefits) and HB 482 (Occupational Licensing and Certification - Criminal History - Predetermination Review Process). Mr. Tran also reported that HB 1199 (Physicians - Licensing - Internationally Trained Physicians) did not pass.
