CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Bhandari, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Physician Licensure

Leonardo De Castro Duraes, M.D. - Postgraduate Training Equivalency

The Licensure Practice of Medicine Committee (LPOMC) reviewed Dr. De Castro Duraes postgraduate training equivalency in colorectal surgery program and recommended that the Board accept his training as equivalent to an ACGME-accredited program.

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On a motion made by <u>Dr. Periera</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Helfenbein</u>, the Board voted to unanimously to accept the LPOMC's recommendation that Dr. De Castro Duraes postgraduate training is equivalent to an ACGME-accredited program.

Executive Director's Update

Board staff stated they are working on Tele-Health regulations with the Secretary's Office, but the Secretary's Office had some concerns with the length of the regulations. They have asked the Board to shorten the regulations.

At its July 11, 2018 meeting, the Board voted to not share licensees' personal emails with the Office of Preparedness and Response and to no longer disclose emails and all other confidential information to other agencies. Staff requested additional guidance on the Board's policy of not sharing confidential information with regard to existing Memorandums of Agreement (MOA) and Memorandums of Understanding (MOU).

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Roca</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Helfenbein</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>APPROVE</u> the policy (1) that the Board will no longer share confidential information and data, including but not limited to licensee emails and dates of birth, and (2) the Board will terminate all of its existing MOA and MOU agreements that include confidential information and data.
