POLICY/LEGISLATION Update

Section 3 of the 2020 Sunset Legislation regarding the Polysomnography and Respiratory Care Committees

Ms. Hawk provided background to the Sunset bill language in Section 3 of the Sunset legislation and updated the Board on the status of the discussion held by members of the Polysomnography and Respiratory Care Committees. The Board voted to support the recommendation from the committee members to maintain both committees, encourage collaboration when overlapping issues arise and hold at least one joint meeting per year.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Pereira</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Boursiquot</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u>, the above recommendations of the committees and notify the Legislative via Letter.

Regulations

Proposed Changes to COMAR 10.32.05 - Telehealth Regulations

Ms. Hawk reviewed the status of the development of the proposed Telehealth regulations and requested Board approval to be submitted for formal publication.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Burgess</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Dills</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> the Telehealth Regulations and to proceed with the promulgation process.

Dental Board Legislative Proposal - Administration of Vaccines and the proposed bill

Ms. Hawk also reviewed the legislative proposal submitted by the Board of Dental Examiners to allow dentists to prescribe and administer vaccines, highlighting the issues. After Board discussion and input, the Board voted to communicate the Board's concerns with the proposal by sending a letter from Dr. Freas.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Boursiquot</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Frank</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> a letter outlining its concerns to the Dental Board.

Draft of proposed regulations - COMAR 10.32.08 Licensure of Athletic Trainers

The Board voted to approve the draft of the proposed revisions to COMAR 10.32.08 Licensure of Athletic Trainers.

On a motion made by <u>Mr. Dills</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Freas</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> the proposed draft regulations, to proceed with the promulgation process and, that the regulations be posted on the website for public comments.

Draft of proposed regulations – COMAR 10.32.01.03G(1)(h)(3) Licensure Qualifications for Initial Licensure

The regulations where a discrepancy currently exists between the statutory requirements the regulations, were therefore, updated to align with the law. The Board voted to approve the draft of the proposed revisions to Licensure - Qualifications for Initial Licensure.

On a motion made by <u>Ms. Schaerr</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Dills</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> the proposed draft regulations, to proceed with the promulgation process and be posted on the website for public comments.
