LEGISLATIVE UPDATE - Mark Woodard, Health Policy Analyst

Mark Woodard summarized HB 591/SB549 Health Occupations-Physician Assistants-Dispensing of Drugs Under a Delegation Agreement to the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee (PAAC).

The House bill authorizes the physician assistant to prepare and dispense a drug that may prescribed under a delegation agreement, if the physician assistant dispenses drugs only within the supervising physician's scope of practice and the scope of the delegation agreement. The bill does not require the physician assistant to apply for and receive a dispensing permit.

Mr. Woodard noted that SB 549 does not have that same authorization despite being noted as cross-filed bills. Mr. Woodard contacted the sponsors of both bills and their staff confirmed that the bills are supposed to be the same and be cross files of each other.

He noted further that the bills do not amend another section of the law that provides for physicians and others to apply for a dispensing permit, nor does it indicate who is to report on the dispensing of drugs to the PDMP database or address the PA's alternative supervising physician.
