Telehealth Regulations

Mr. Woodard and Mr. Finkler asked the Board to approve the re-publication of the Telehealth regulations that the Board approved at its January 30, 2019 meeting due to a stakeholder's comments, which staff considered substantive enough to require re-publication in the Maryland Register.

On a motion made by <u>Ms. Schaerr</u>, and seconded by <u>Ms. Turnipseed</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>APPROVE</u> the revised Telehealth regulations re-publication in the Maryland Register and to proceed with promulgation process.

Ms. Hawk informed the Board that the Audit bill, HB 638 has been introduced and the hearing has been scheduled for February 26, 2019 at 1:00 pm. Board Members were encouraged to attend.
