UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Review Recommended Revisions to Appendixes C1 & C2 of the E&T Protocol

The Committee reviewed the revisions to Appendixes C1 & C2 of the E&T Protocol and recommended the following revisions:

Appendix C1:

- The second paragraph should read, “Complete **Appendix C1** only if the supervising physician is planning to delegate specialized tasks to the AT that are beyond the basic tasks in **Appendix B**. Tasks should be appropriate to the setting(s) listed in the evaluation and treatment protocol.”
- The third paragraph should read, “ATs will not be approved to perform specialized tasks until after the Board has approved the evaluation and treatment protocol with specialized tasks. *If the Board has previously approved the specialized task(s), an AT may assume the duties after receiving preliminary approval from Board staff.* See **Appendix C2**.
- Add a period (.) after the 2nd bulleted sentence under “Instructions for the Athletic Trainer and Supervising Physician:”

Appendix C2:

- Under Category I, change the capital “T” in the word That to a lower case “t”.
- Under Category I, change “Interpreting a Neuro-Psych Concussion Test (Immediate Post-Concussion Assessment and Cognitive Testing-Impact.)” read “Interpreting an ImPACT Neuro-Psych Concussion Test (Immediate Post-Concussion Assessment and Cognitive Testing – ImPACT Application, Inc...).
