#### CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Ajrawat, Board Chair called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### Physician Assistants Delegation Agreement Addendum for Advanced Duties

The Physician Assistant Advisory Committee (PAAC) determined that the physician assistants meet the criteria for advanced duties established in statute and regulations, and voted to recommend approval of the addendums to the Board.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Wiesenberger</u>, and seconded by <u>Ms. Orbach</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> all addendum requests to perform the advanced duties in attachment 1.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Ganti</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Scholz</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> the full Board and Panel minutes.

#### **POLICY/LEGISLATION**

#### Policy

• House Bill No. 676: Right to Try Act – Individualized Investigational Treatments for Discussion

Ms. Harris presented House Bill 676 - Right to Try Act. The bill would update current law to add the definition of individualized investigational treatment, eligible patient, and eligible facility. The bill would remove terminally ill and replace it with individualized investigational treatment. The Board has submitted a letter of information to the Health and Government Operations Committee. Board members discussed the bill's updates and decided to keep a neutral position for House Bill 676.

#### Regulations

• Proposed Regulations - Administrative Expungement

Ms. DelGreco sought a vote from the Board to affirm approval of pending regulations COMAR 10.32.02.02 and 10.32.02.18. The Board voted to affirm approval.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Cymet</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Scholz</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> to affirm the Proposed Regulations – Administrative Expungement.

#### LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Mr. Dudzic updated the Board on the 2024 session of the Maryland General Assembly. Mr. Dudzic provided the Board with the latest Physician Assistant Modernization Act status. He discussed HB 934/SB 830, a bill establishing limited-scope x-ray machine operators in Maryland under the Board. Mr. Dudzic informed the Board that the bill sponsors had thus far accepted feedback from the Board, including the creation of a registration process and sunset provision, increasing the clinical and didactic hours of training required, limiting supervision to a physician or a radiologic technologist and narrowing the method of required supervision to on-site and immediately available. Mr. Dudzic explained that there were still some remaining issues, including the program's effective date and instituting a civil penalty for registered operators.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Scholz</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Ganti</u>, the Board voted 8 to 6 to <u>APPROVE</u> the support of HB 934/SB 830 with amendments.

#### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

• FYI - Continuing Compact Violations and Lack of Transparency

Ms. Farrelly asked Mr. Finkler to update the Board on the continuing violations and the lack of transparency with the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact including its Executive Committee. As a reminder, Mr. Finkler reviewed the Board's previous attempts to resolve the Compact's violations and lack of transparency by advising the EC of the problems with the RFP for the

enhanced physician portal, continuing to request that the EC notify the Commission of its decisions and policy changes, and presenting the Board's recommended policies and bylaw changes at the Annual Meeting in November of 2023. Staff and Counsel also attended the Rules Committee to discuss the Board's proposed bylaw changes earlier this month.

Mr. Finkler reviewed that the Board provided a letter to Ms. Silas, Chair of the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Committee, which was sent (via email only). The letter addressed several concerns regarding Statutes, Bylaws, Rules, and policies that IMLCC violated. It also included that commissioners were deliberately excluded from closed session meetings, but according to the "Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, 12th edition, 9:26." Commissioners should never be excluded from discussions.

The letter concluded by asking Ms. Silas to confirm by responding to the letter that she understands what has been occurring and to re-commit the Executive Committee to oversee the Executive Director and his staff to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Compact in the future.

Ms. Farrelly advised that there was another "secret" meeting on February 26, 2024. The website stated that the meeting will be closed immediately with only the invited leadership team and staff participating in the closed session. The meeting was scheduled as a result of the Treasurer's concern with the fees and expenditures related to the contract for the enhanced physician portal.
