## LEGISLATION, REGULATIONS, AND POLICY UPDATES

SB 830 - Radiation Therapy, Radiography, Nuclear Medicine Technology, and Radiology Assistance- Limited Licensed Radiologic Technologist

Mr. Dudzic reviewed SB 830, which would allow unlicensed radiographers to perform specific X-ray duties, primarily in outpatient settings such as urgent care centers. He informed the Committee how other states handle regulating limited licensed radiologic technologists. He asked the Committee for their views on licensure versus registration, appropriate supervision, and required training for these limited-scope professionals.

The Committee indicated that registration was a reasonable first step to oversee these professionals and that supervision should be limited to physicians and radiographers. There were no objections to the required training level set forth by the bill.
