BOARD COUNSEL REPORT

Mr. Finkler informed the Committee that the Board of Physicians is working on telehealth regulations and that the current draft of regulations permits Allied Health practitioners to perform telehealth within the practitioners' scope of practice. Mr. Finkler asked the Committee if athletic trainers (ATs) practice telehealth and requested the ATs on the Committee to provide examples of tasks that athletic trainers might provide remotely. The ATs gave examples of remotely aiding with home exercise programs, reviewing symptoms to determine whether the patient needs to see a physician, and reviewing progress or changes with a patient after an in-person initial evaluation may be conducted via audio/visual telehealth.
