Revisions to E&T Protocol – Athletic Trainers treatment of injuries

Dr. Morganti suggested adding additional information to the evaluation and treatment protocol that will assist with identifying athletic trainer's practicing with industrial agencies that may be treating athletes and/or treating employees. After a brief discussion, the Committee agreed to

amend # 15 on the E&T Protocol application (ATHLETIC TRAINER'S PRACTICE SETTINGS) to reflect the following:

- 1) Change "Check all that may apply" to "Check only those that apply"
- 2) Add an * next to "Corporation (ex: Pivot, ATI) and Government Agency.
- 3) Remove PRN
- 4) Add an * and the following statement to the bottom of section 15.

* If Corporation and/or Government Agency are checked, will you be treating only athletic injuries?
 Yes No. If no, please attach your job description.
