Mr. Tran informed the Board that the Advisory Commission on Additional Licensing Models (the Commission) released its second set of recommendations on the alternative licensure pathway for internationally trained physicians (FTPs). The second set of recommendations focused on the supervision of FTPs rather than the previous recommendation's focus on applicant qualifications.

PAs performing organ procurement for Discussion

Mr. Tran informed the Board that a Maryland hospital has inquired about a Physician Assistant's ability to perform organ procurement and sternotomy as an advanced duty. Mr. Tran and Ms. Wright reviewed and discussed the documentation submitted to the Board. The Board voted not to add organ procurement and sternotomy to the list of advanced procedures performed by a physician assistant.

On a motion made by <u>Ms. Schaerr</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Caffrey</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>**DECLINE**</u> adding the above request to the list of advanced procedures performed by a physician assistant.

Ms. Farrelly informed the Board of the letter from Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., to all State Medical Boards advising them of the dangers and long-term effects of the treatments for Pediatric Gender Dysphoria.
