Reinstatement of Medical License - Special Purpose Examination (SPEX)

Postgraduate Training Equivalency

The Licensure Practice of Medicine Committee (LPOMC) recommended that the Board accept Dr. Dhawan's clinical fellowship training in hand and microsurgery program as equivalent to an ACGME-accredited program.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Pereira</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Bhandari</u>, the Board voted to unanimously accept the LPOMC's recommendation and <u>APPROVE</u> Dr. Dhawan's clinical fellowship training in hand and microsurgery program as equivalent to an ACGME-accredited program to proceed with licensure.

Board Counsel's Report

Board Counsel reported on the opinion of the Circuit Court for Baltimore County in Rosen vs. Maryland State Board of Physicians, Civil action No. 03-C-17006833, which was issued by the circuit court on March 9, 2018.

The court affirmed the Board's Final Decision and Order that Dr. Rosen's prescribing of opioids deviated from the standard of care, and also affirmed the Board's sanction of a Reprimand.

The court reversed the Board's decision that Dr. Rosen's supervision of a physician assistant constituted unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, and remanded that issue for a ruling in accordance with the court's opinion.

The court's written opinion has not yet been received.

The Board adjourned its open meeting at 9:07 a.m.
