On a motion made by <u>Dr. Rosenstein</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Brody</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>**DENY**</u> the addendum requests to perform the aforementioned advanced duties following the recommendation of the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee.

Physician Assistant's Delegated Psychiatric Duties (Advanced)

Board staff asked the Board to consider if psychiatric acts delegated to a physician assistant by a psychiatrist are advanced duties. The Board and Physician Assistant Advisory Committee (PAAC) previously reviewed psychiatric duties delegated to a physician assistant. Since that time, there has been an increase in the number of submitted delegation agreements between a psychiatrist and physician assistant.

As a result, Board staff met with the Psychiatrist Board Member and the Board's Medical Consultant. Both agreed that due to the nature of the psychiatrist's scope of practice, delegated psychiatric acts require additional education, training and experience beyond the basic physician assistant education program and therefore should be considered advanced duties.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Walsh</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Roca</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>APPROVE</u> delegated psychiatric acts to a physician assistant as advanced duties.

Athletic Trainers Evaluation and Treatment Protocols

The Athletic Trainers Advisory Committee reviewed the Evaluation and Treatment Protocols, determined that the athletic trainers meet the criteria established in statute, and voted to recommend approval to the Board.
