APPROVAL OF MINUTES

LEGISLATION, REGULATIONS, AND POLICY UPDATES

Review of COMAR 10.32.10

Ms. Van Horn clarified the changes in COMAR 10.32.10.04, 05, .05-1, and .05-2 regarding language about the ARRT and NMTCB. The Committee agreed to add a definition of "disciplinary panel" to COMAR 10.32.10.02.

Ms. Van Horn informed the Committee that during the 2021 legislative session, the Department of Legislative Services introduced Senate Bill 877 "Annual Corrective Bill", which included a change in the number of committee members from ten to nine under Health Occupations Article, §14-5B-05, Annotated Code of Maryland.

On a motion made by Ms. Lewis and seconded by Dr. Neuner, the Committee unanimously voted to recommend the revised draft regulations to the Board for approval.

NEW BUSINESS


