On November 20, 2019, the Maryland Board of Physicians (the Board) reviewed the Delegation Agreement Addendum for Advanced Duties for Ms. Bender to perform the following procedure under the supervision of Dr. Kang:

• Excisions on malignant lesions confirmed by pathology, premalignant lesions, symptomatic benign lesions, excisional biopsy for diagnostics and therapeutic purposes

The Board tabled its review of the advanced duties addendum (including the submitted procedure log listing 12 excision procedures). The Board requests the additional information bulleted below:

- Procedure log of all procedures performed under Dr. Kang (to include types of excisions)
- Number of procedures that Ms. Bender has performed in the presence of Dr. Kang (or alternate supervising physicians)
- Associated pathology reports for all procedures

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Olszyk</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Dills</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>TABLE</u> the addendum requests for Ms. Bender, PA-C and Dr. Kang pending further information and to discuss at its December 18, 2019 meeting.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Olszyk</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Dills</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>APPROVE</u> all addendum requests to perform the aforementioned advanced duties following the recommendation of the Physician Assistant Advisory Committee, with the exception of the request for Ms. Bender, PA-C and Dr. Kang.
