# POLICY/LEGISLATION

### Policy

• FYI - FSMB Strategies for Prescribing Opioids for the Management of Pain Ms. Harris presented on behalf of Ms. Delgreco on an FYI of a current Report by the FSMB on the opioid epidemic and ensuring that patients have appropriate access to evidence-based pain care. Recommendations were made by an FSMB Workgroup on current opioid policies. FSMB has open comments on the Report until December 1, 2023. Board members were directed to submit any questions or comments on the Report to the FSMB.

• Foreign Medical Graduates for Discussion

Mr. Tran informed the Board of a potential 2024 Maryland Legislative Session bill that would explore alternative pathways to licensure for international medical graduates who did not complete an official residency program here in the United States.

• MHCC User Assessment Fees for Approval

"Mr. Dudzic discussed the Maryland Health Care Commission fee of \$26 assessed on all renewing health care practitioners. Mr. Dudzic informed the Board that the Board previously agreed to pay this fee on behalf of its licensees through fiscal year 2023 as part of an initiative to reduce licensing fees. The Board discussed whether the user assessment fee should resume being collected in fiscal year 2024 or if the Board should continue to waive this fee. The Board requested additional information from the Board's fiscal and operations units to be presented to the Board at its December meeting."

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Wiesenberger</u>, and seconded by <u>Ms. Connerney</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>**TABLE**</u> for a future meeting to receive additional information concerning the FY24 and FY25 budget.

# LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Mr. Dudzic informed the Board that the Administration officially approved both of the Board's legislative proposals and agreed to take on its Reorganizations and Revisions bill as a departmental bill.
