POLICY/LEGISLATION

For Update and Discussion Dental Board – Draft of Proposed Legislation – Updated

MSBDE President, Dr. Jim Goldsmith; Vice President, Dr. Arpana Verma, and immediate Past-President, Dr. Arthur Jee, appeared to discuss the proposed Dental Board Vaccine legislation. The Board generally supported the proposal and reserved the opportunity to make comments on the regulations that may contain more detail. Beyond the specific Dental Board proposal, there were lingering questions raised, after the Dental Board representatives left the meeting, as to how ImmuNet was working and concerns about penalties and discipline for failure to report to ImmuNet. No vote was taken.

Acupuncture Board – Draft of proposed regulations

Ms. Hawk presented an overview of the history of the passage of legislation, other stakeholder issues, correspondence received and specific issues with the therapies and procedures allowed in the Acupuncture Board's proposed regulations. Acupuncture Board representatives were invited to respond to Board questions. After discussion, the Board requested more information and detail for certain enumerated therapies that seem very broad, such as the collection and interpretation of clinical data.

COVID Licensure Waiver for established practitioner patient relationship

David Finkler presented about revisiting the Board's suspension of certain licensure provisions. The Board allowed out-of-state practitioners in existing relationship with a Maryland patient, to continue to treat Maryland patients without a license. After six months under the State of Emergency the Board considered rescinding that provision and requiring individuals practicing in Maryland to obtain Maryland licenses. After a discussion that considered issues regarding safety, accountability, and issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board voted to rescind the exception after an additional 6 months, allowing ample time for practitioners to obtain a Maryland license through reciprocity, the compact or traditional means, or to transfer care.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Olszyk</u>, and seconded by <u>Dr. Wallace</u>, the Board voted unanimously to rescind the COVID Licensure Waiver for established practitioner patient relationship and provide 6 months to obtain Maryland licensure. Dr. Berkowitz recused.

Title 15 – Physician Assistants Statutory Rewrite

Wynee Hawk along with David Finkler presented draft language for a statutory rewrite of the Physician Assistant statute (Title 15). The statute is being rewritten for clarity, to clear up misinterpretations and to further protect Maryland patients. The draft is only a starting point and has been shared with MAPA, MedChi, the PA Workgroup, PAAC, and individual physicians and physician assistants. MAPA has repeatedly been asked for suggested draft language and specific comments but has only replied with unsupported generalizations. The content of a letter received by MAPA late yesterday was shared. The Board discussed advanced duties and other issues of concern and recommended continuing the process of rewriting the language while continuing to obtain recommendations to the language from stakeholders.

Regulations Proposed Regulations – COMAR 10.32.08 – Licensure of Athletic Trainer Regulations

COMAR 10.32.08 Licensure of Athletic Trainers required updated to comply with HB 560 (Ch. 612)/SB 395 (Ch. 613) and SB 732 (Ch. 579). After receiving no public comment, the Board voted to approve the draft of the proposed revisions to COMAR 10.32.08 to proceed to the next stage of the promulgation process.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Plavner</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Dills</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> the proposed draft regulations revisions to proceed with the promulgation process.

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Proposed Regulations COMAR 10.32.01.03G(1)(h)(3) – Licensure Qualifications for Initial Licensure

COMAR 10.32.01.03G(1)(h)(3) required updates to come into alignment with the statutory requirements found in H.O. 14-307(g)(2)(ii). After receiving no public comment, the Board voted to approve the draft of the proposed revisions to COMAR 10.32.01.03G(1)(h)(3) to proceed to the next stage of the promulgation process.

On a motion made by <u>Ms. Schaerr</u>, and seconded by <u>Mr. Dills</u>, the Board voted to unanimously <u>APPROVE</u> the proposed draft regulations revisions to proceed with the promulgation process.
