**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Review Revisions to E&T Protocol**

The Committee reviewed staff's recommended revisions to the E&T Protocol, and on a motion made by Mr. Shipley and seconded by Mr. Sataloff, the Committee voted to accept the staff's recommended changes to the E&T Protocol.

**Review/Update List of Board Approved Specialized Task**

The Committee reviewed the Athletic Trainers' List of Board-Approved Specialized Tasks. After a lengthy discussion, on a motion made by Dr. Wilkens and seconded by Mr. Shipley, the Committee recommended that the Board remove the following Specialized Tasks from the list of Board-Approved Specialized tasks, as the tasks have been incorporated into the athletic trainer's education:

- Brace fitting and measurement

- Administering a Neuro-Psych Concussion Test. The Committee agreed that “Interpreting a Neuro-Psych Concussion Test” should remain as specialized task.
- Concussion Management
- Incision and drainage procedures for blisters and/or subungual hematomas of the fingers and/or toes, water-based ear lavage, and administration of topical adhesive
- Splinting
- Staple removal
- Suture removal
- Assist in the use of Epi pen in case of allergic reaction
- Ability to use an otoscope and ophthalmoscope to recognize ears, nose, throat and eye abnormalities
- Ability to use glucometer to monitor blood glucose levels

There being no further business, on a motion made by Mr. Shipley and seconded by Dr. Omohundro, the committee unanimously voted to adjourn its meeting at 11:03 a.m.
