#### Dental Board - Draft of Proposed Legislation - UPDATED for Discussion

Ms. Hawk updated the Board on the Dental Board's response to the Board's letter of concern about their proposed legislation. After discussion, the Board recommended to accept the Dental Board's offer to have representatives at a future meeting to respond to questions. Ms. Hawk will invite the Dental Board to the next Panel B meeting.

#### **Acupuncture Draft Regulations**

Ms. Hawk reviewed the background and issues with proposed regulations from the Acupuncture Board. More information is needed to determine what some of the procedures entail. Ms. Hawk will follow-up with the Board.

#### **Approved Athletic Trainers Specialized Tasks List**

Ms. Douglas-Smith presented recommendations from the Athletic Trainer Advisory Committee (ATAC) and Mr. Brian Perez, Chair of the ATAC was available for questions on these specialized tasks, the ATs educational curriculum, and the AT training.

The ATAC reviewed each of the tasks on the Athletic Trainers Specialized Task List at its last meeting. The ATAC is recommending that the Board remove certain procedures because the tasks are now covered in the ATs educational curriculum. The other specialized tasks require additional training so there is no recommended change and these will remain on the list.
