Second, the draft proposal of the update to Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 10.32.10 will be posted on the Board's Website to invite informal comments.


Ms. Van Horn provided additional information about the proposed RCIS regulations. The Committee asked staff to provide further background on the RCIS regulations at the next Committee meeting.
