Category 2 Continuing Medical Education Reporting Form

The MD Board of Physicians (the “Board”) requires physicians to document the AMA PRA Category 2 credits they have completed to fulfill the Board’s Continuing Medical Education (CME) requirement of not more than 25 Category 2 CME credit hours for license renewal or reinstatement. Physicians are responsible for documenting their AMA PRA Category 2 credit activities.

The American Medical Association (AMA) defines AMA PRA Category 2 credit activities as self-designated, self-claimed educational activities that have not been formally designated by an accredited educational provider for AMA PRA Category 1 credit. Physicians may claim Category 2 credit for participation in learning experiences that meet the following criteria: Comply with the AMA’s definition of CME, are non-promotional, and are beneficial or related to the physician’s practice. Credit cannot be claimed for experiences incidental to a physician's employment or regular professional activities, such as learning from clinical experience. **Credits claimed should be commensurate with the actual time spent on an activity.** Category 2 credit is not awarded for passing licensing or board certification examinations.

If the Board selects you for a CME audit, or if you are applying to reinstate your medical license and have learning activities that meet the requirements for AMA PRA Category 2, the Board is providing this form to document these activities.

This form should be used only to report your Category 2 activities. For Category 1 credits, you must submit either the actual certificates awarding credit or the transcript that the educational provider issued. Please note:

- If you’re applying for reinstatement of your medical license, you can upload the completed form to your reinstatement application.
- If you are selected for a CME audit, send the completed form to the following email address: mdh.mbprenewal@maryland.gov.
