4. Policy

Wynee Hawk presented the Policy/Legislative Report. The Board expressed concerns related to usage, dispensing, safety, and regulations regarding the Medical Marijuana Bill. Staff will thoroughly review the Medical Marijuana legislation and review at the May 27, 2015 at Panel B Meeting. A Bill Hearing is scheduled for April 1, 2015 and staff will prepare written comments. Background Checks have passed in both the Senate and House. Hearings will be scheduled in the opposite chambers. The Shielding Bill is unrelated, but indirectly affects the Board. The Board was able to amend the Bill to allow the full review of applicant's criminal history to health occupation licensing boards. Physician Assistants and Athletic Training Bills were withdrawn due to discrepancies. The Midwives Bill is heavily amended and will continue to move forward. The Mandated Continuing Medical Education Bill/Cultural Competency has been amended to be acceptable. A tracking system has been provided to the Legislative Committee on a weekly basis and out of the eighteen priority Bills approximately 10 or 11 Bills still remain and are moving.

BOARD VOTE TO CLOSE SESSION
