**Conceded Eminence License**

Jonathan J. Morrison, M.D. and Simon D. Pollett, M.D.

Board staff presented Dr. Morrison’s and Dr. Pollett’s applications for renewal of their licenses by conceded eminence and recommended approval.

*On a motion made by Mr. Brody, and seconded by Dr. Rosenstein, the Board voted to unanimously **APPROVE** Dr. Morrison’s and Dr. Pollett’s licensure renewals by conceded eminence.*

**POLICY/LEGISLATION**

Dr. Ross VanAntwerp contacted the Board and indicated that he would like to hire an unlicensed medical assistant to perform light chemical peels. He considers light chemical peels to be similar to microdermabrasion, which is not covered by the cosmetic medical procedure regulations.

Staff asked the Board to determine if performing light chemical peels, such as glycolic peels, are a cosmetic medical procedure. Staff recommended two options to the Board. One option is to clarify the definition in COMAR 10.32.09.02 to define “light chemical peel” as a cosmetic medical procedure. The second option is to add “light chemical peel” to the list of procedures

that can be performed by an assistant without on-site supervision in COMAR 10.32.12.04D.

The Board directed staff to work with Board counsel to come up with definitions to clarify light and deep chemical peels.

*On a motion made by Ms. Schaerr, and seconded by Ms. Turnipseed, the Board voted unanimously to **TABLE** this item until the January 24, 2018 full Board meeting.*
