

Practitioner Profile Updates

Do you need to change your mailing or primary practice address with the Board?

Do you need to update your email address?

Do you need to add/delete Hospital Privileges?

All licensed practitioners can edit/change their demographic information through the Online Practitioner Profile. The changes you submit through the profile update to the Board's internal database within 24 hours.

The steps to change your profile are as follows:

1. Go to the Board's website at <https://www.mbp.state.md.us/>
2. On the right hand side of the home page click "Practitioner Profiles" (see Figure A)
